Through the program, he came to work for SATLANTIS, LLC, a space-tech satellite startup based in UF's Innovation Hub. Joseph started out as a marketing intern, but grew to wear many hats. He played a role in sales, business development, and recruiting talent. During his tenure at the company, he generated 30+ business leads, negotiated a ~\$10,000 advertisement budget, developed automation that saved 10+ hours each week, and recruited 50% of the software engineering team.

Next, Joseph interned as a summer analyst for Vocap Partners, a series A venture capital fund based in Atlanta, Georgia. They have previously invested in B2B software companies like Blue Ridge and XOI Technologies. Joseph worked on deal sourcing by vetting hundreds of companies; and due diligence by creating financial models in Excel.
