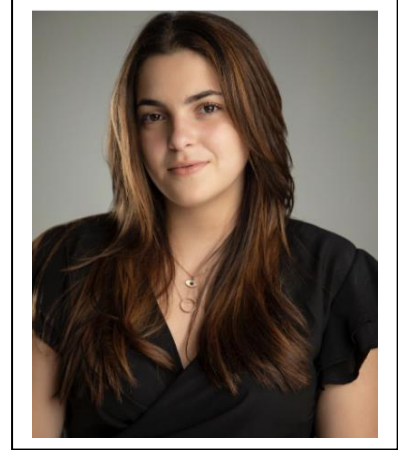


Sofia Hernandez
