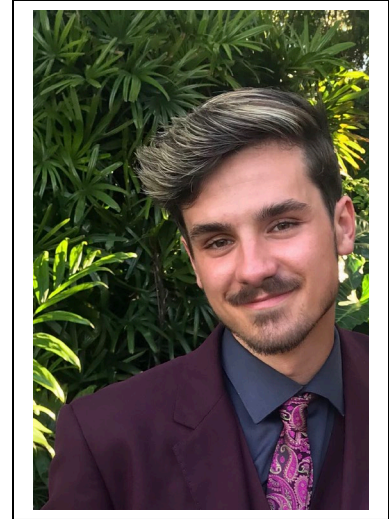


Nicholas Bonhoure
